Very little feedback from initial emails:

1) ██████████ owner of The Mango Tree:

He lives in Birmingham and so did not want to comment on the village, however from his businesses' point of view, the more building of houses that occurs the better, because then his restaurant gets more trade.

2) ██████████ Lee Academy:

As the principal of the Lee Academy I have rented the village hall for over twenty years.

My concerns regarding the village hall being extended and then running two activities at the same time are of serious safe guarding issues .

I have young children and adults in my supervision and have staff who are trained and vetted only working with them. Other members of the public would become an insurance issue .

Regarding the increase in housing in the village I welcome affordable housing and provided the safety on the roads is considered I feel this would be good for the village hall users. I would like to attend the open meetings and would like to fill out a questionnaire although I do not live in the village.

3) ██████████ Methodist Church:
