	Chairperson Roy Mitchell welcomed everyone to the meeting of the Stoke Golding Neighbourhood Development Plan Advisory Committee (SGNDPAC).	Tasks allocated

	Prior to the formal meeting commencing Richard Mugglestone from Midlands Rural Housing gave a talk on the Housing Needs Survey that will be done in Stoke Golding at the behest of Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council. He wants to conduct the survey at a time which is convenient for the village and the Neighbourhood Development Plan process that is underway.	
	An 8 page questionnaire will go to each household and business. The emphasis is on assessing the demand for affordable housing in the village. The final report will consider if the need for affordable housing will be met by current developments in the village or whether land is required for new developments.	
	This survey is being done throughout Leicestershire and it has been combined with a Neighbourhood Plan Survey (Great Easton), but equally could be conducted before or after it. He suggested the timescale for the Housing Needs Survey would be: - a month to get the survey out, a month for the survey to be completed then a month for the report to be compiled.	
	The Parish Council will decide when the Housing Needs Survey is to take place, but would appreciate the view of SGNDPAC.

6.	To recommend a Consultant to the Parish Council The minutes of the SGNDPAC for March did not tally with the Parish Council minutes. Clarification has been sent to all members of SGNDPAC. At the March meeting the community present voted in favour of Kirkwells. Stewart Anderson proposed that SGNDPAC recommends the appointment of Kirkwells as consultant to the Parish Council. Jim Hope seconded this proposal and all present at the meeting agreed. Written agreement had	

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	also been received from Sarah Beale and Steve Martin. If this recommendation is accepted by the Parish Council they will appoint Kirkwells to help in the production of the NP. A grant will be obtained before any expenditure is incurred.

However, following the talk by Richard Mugglestone at the start of the meeting it was proposed by Glyn Chapman that a recommendation is made to the Parish Council for an early submission of the Housing Needs Survey, with a suitable covering letter. This was seconded by Jim Hope and unanimously agreed by those present.
